

Actions of the USATT High Performance Committee (HPC)
April – May 2015

During April – May 2014, the HPC did not hold any formal meetings or conference calls. However, the following summary of its actions and discussions is offered to inform USATT members about the HPC's activities conducted by email, and through participation in the other USATT activities.
